

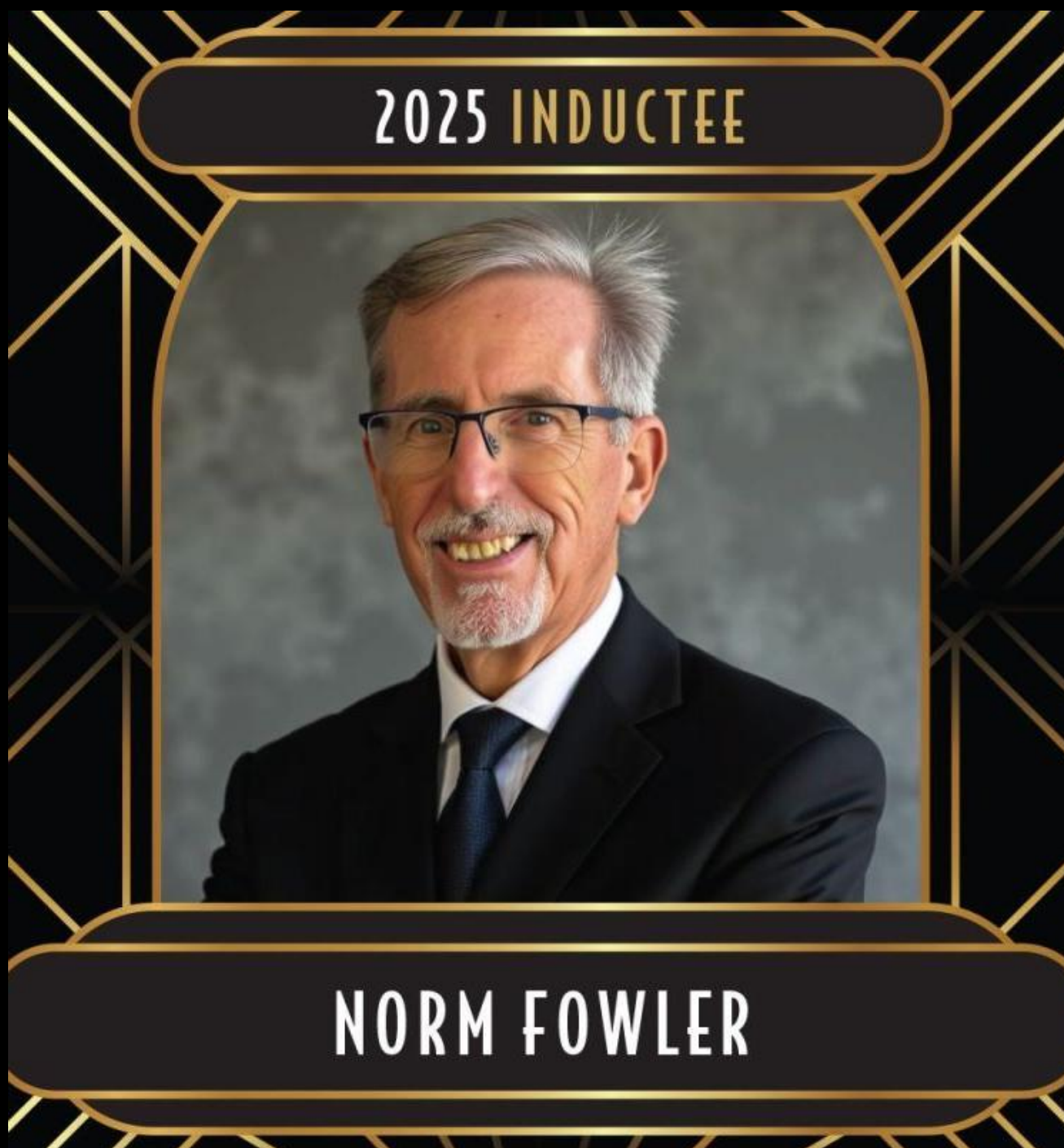

Plastics Hall of Fame

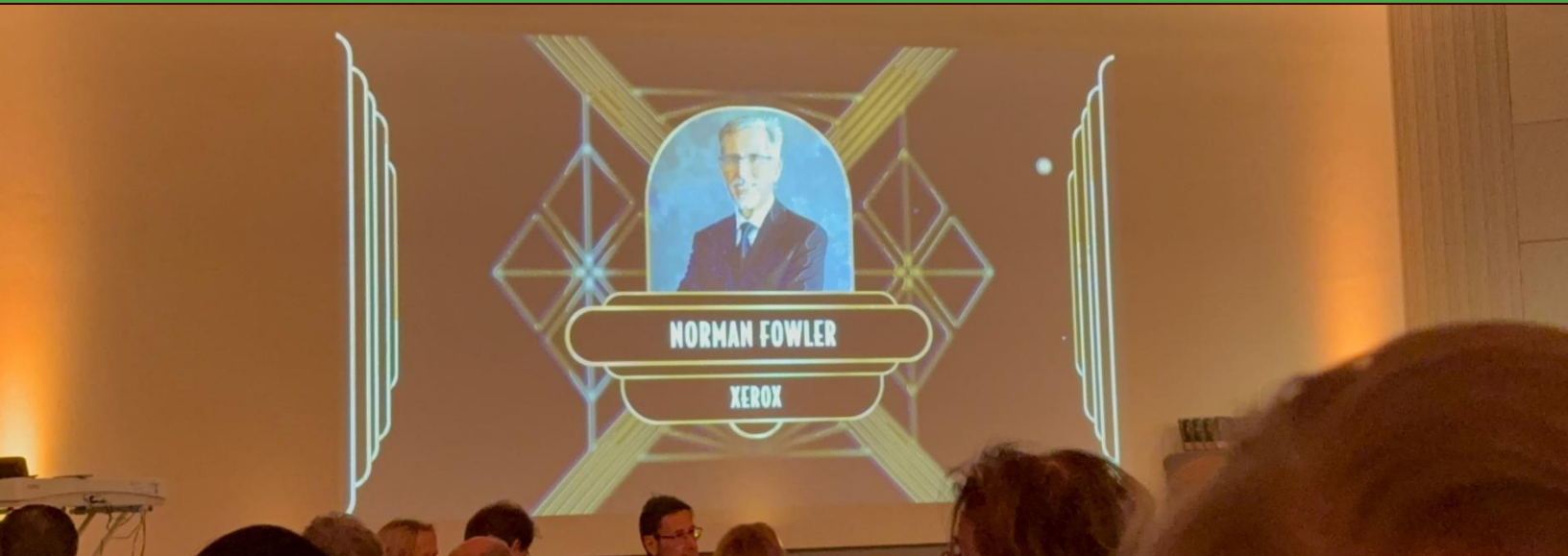
The Plastics Hall of Fame is the premier international institution honoring plastic innovators and leaders by showcasing their achievements and inspiring future visionaries.

Plastics Hall of Fame



Norman E. Fowler has been a driving force in advancing polymer engineering, manufacturing excellence, and professional leadership for more than fifty years. His career includes a distinguished tenure at Xerox, where he guided global engineering and production teams responsible for critical subsystem technologies. Under his direction, the organization implemented breakthrough elastomer-processing methods, strengthened global supply continuity, and delivered substantial cost efficiencies. Fowler's technical leadership supported the commercialization of next-generation fusing technologies and contributed to an extensive portfolio of intellectual property, including dozens of patents. A passionate advocate for disciplined innovation, Fowler helped establish structured readiness frameworks and championed Lean Six Sigma and Design for Lean Six Sigma practices long before they became industry standards. His focus on scalable training models accelerated capability building across international engineering groups. Within the Society of Plastics Engineers, Fowler's contributions have been equally profound. Active since the 1970s, he progressed through numerous volunteer and executive roles, ultimately serving as SPE International President. His strategic guidance strengthened member engagement, student outreach, and long-term organizational planning—impacting generations of plastics professionals. His legacy continues to inspire innovation and leadership across the SPE community.
